

Brameier named Lacrosse Director of Sono Field House

This might be listed under 'no-brainers.' But still, for the Sono Field House, there could have been no smarter move.

The Sono Field House sports facility has named Wave veteran coach Jeff Brameier as its Lacrosse Director, the organization announced today.

As Lacrosse Director the many-times-champion DHS coach will manage "all facets of lacrosse programming for the field house, including clinics, leagues, tournaments and camps," the SFH press release stated.

"Jeff Brameier was the standout choice for this role," said Jim Quinn, CEO and Founder of Sono Field House, which is set to open its doors in the autumn. "Jeff's outstanding reputation and experience in coaching all levels of athletes is unsurpassed, making him a perfect fit for a facility of this caliber.

Brameier has coached for over 20 years, with stints at Darien High that include guiding boys swimming and football. And he coaches club swimming in town.

"Jeff has done an excellent job of growing the sport of lacrosse in Connecticut and has great connections throughout Fairfield County," Quinn added.

In "Coach B" Quinn has brought aboard the winningest active coach in Connecticut, and one who has put up 413 wins in his 26 years behind the Wave bench, plus been named "Connecticut Coach of the Year" in 1988, 1992, 1997 and 1999.

He has coached 11 FCIAC and seven state championship teams, as well as 57 high school All-Americans and 97 All-State players. He's served as president of the Connecticut High School Lacrosse Coaches Association for 22 years.

And Brameier is the founder of Elite Sports Camps and the director of the Future Star Sport Camps.

"Jeff has stepped into his new role immediately in order to ensure the program curriculum is ready for the facility's opening later this fall," said Quinn. "Jeff brings with him an elite coaching staff from local area high schools and youth programs."

Quality lacrosse clinics and leagues at the youth and adult levels are already scheduled for the opening Fall/Winter Session at Sono.
